Centennial Calendar

This calendar will feature 12 homes built 100 years ago, in 1912. Six of the homes are the houses that will be on the Centennial Historic Home Tour. The other 16 homes built in 1912 will be represented in small photos throughout the calendar. The cover of the calendar is a reproduction of an advertisement for McFadden & Buxton - "The System Firm" - that created Burlingame. Each month will have the dates for all BNA and BC meetings and special activities.

The calendars will sell for \$15.00. A couple samples will be available to see at the Burlingame Block Party on Saturday, September 10th. Calendars will only be available through pre-order at the Block Party or after, and will be delivered before the end of 2011.

This calendar will be a special and useful way to commemorate our centennial year. Think of sharing our centennial year with family and friends.

CONGRATULATIONS TO KATHY & PETER!

In May the City of San Diego Historical Resources Board gave their Award of Excellence for Architectural Restoration to the new homeowners of 2405 Dulzura, Kathy Hodges and Peter Thomas. In presenting the award, the Historical Resources Board confirmed that this 1924 Spanish Eclectic home now meets the designation criteria to become a contributor to the Burlingame Historic District. In 2007 the Board had rejected the property as a contributing resource because of several alterations to the original structure and significant loss of integrity.

If your home has been denied historic designation in the past, you may also be able to restore your property to become a contributing resource to our historic district and become eligible for the Mills Act property tax reduction. Kathy and Peter would be happy to share with other Burlingame homeowners what they learned in the process. They also thank all of their Burlingame neighbors (especially the 2010 BNA Board and Connie DiGirolamo, in particular) who were so helpful to them. (And yes, the Dulzura front yard will be restored soon, too!)

BURLINGAME CLUB STARTS NEW YEAR

The first meeting will be September 15 at Lynn Scelfo's home, 2416 Pamo, at 7 pm. Every woman in Burlingame is invited to join the group. The program for this meeting will be a short talk and discussion of Gustav Stickley by Scot Jaffe, Associate Director of Exhibitions and Collections at the San Diego Museum of Art *and Burlingame resident*. This is what the Museum has to say about the current exhibit:

"The San Diego Museum of Art is proud to present *Gustav Stickley and the American Arts and Crafts Movement*. Organized by the Dallas Museum of Art, this is the first nationally touring exhibition to focus on the career of Stickley (1858–1942), one of the leading figures of the American Arts and Crafts movement. The exhibition will examine Stickley's contributions to the history of American design and architecture during his most productive and creative period, from 1900 to 1913, and will provide new insights into the artistic, commercial, and social context of Stickley's work. From *The Craftsman* magazine to his own stores in New York, Washington and Boston, Stickley offered customers a complete lifestyle based on his philosophy of simple design and quality materials. Ranging from furniture to metalware and embroidered textiles to architectural designs, the majority of the more than 100 objects in the exhibition are from private collections and have never been seen before by the public".
