Bylaws Amendments Adopted

A subcommittee of the Board of Directors met and reviewed the bylaws of the association. Changes including the following items were adopted at the Board of Directors' February meeting and are of particular note:

- Change the name to be consistent with the Articles of Incorporation as amended last year (BHA to BNA)
- Simplify and clarify the definition of members and remove any distinction in voting rights
- Clarify that voting is one per home
- Clarify the term of membership to be a calendar year
- Restate the removal from office provisions to be consistent with the California Corporations Code
- State explicitly that board meetings are open to members
- Change the "Executive Secretary" title to "Vice President" but no change in duties
- Add a provision to allow electronic participation by Directors in board meetings consistent with California Corporations Code
