Some successful yard sale tips:

- Put stickers or pieces of tape with prices on items before the sale starts.
- Group like items together and place on blankets or old sheets. Consider putting small items together in a box or bag and selling for one price.
- Hang clothing on a rack and have a mirror handy.
- Arrange easy access to an electric outlet so people can test appliances and include manuals if you have them.
- Wear your Burlingame tee-shirt or a name tag so people know who is in charge and taking money.
- Remember yard sales are usually not the best place to sell items of great value. You should consult a consignment shop or dealer.
- Have plenty of small bills and some change to start the yard sale- \$50 composed of \$5's and \$1's should cover it. A small calculator, a pad and pen can be helpful also.
- Be safe-keep your money with you at all times, secure your house, keep your pets out of the way, and watch your items so things don't walk away.
- Be prepared to bargain and don't be afraid to say 'no thanks' to an offer.
- Have plastic bags handy for people to take away their items and newspaper or other wrapping paper for delicate pieces.
- Consider donating items that did not sell to a charity of your choice.
