COMMUNITY RELATIONS OFFICER Attended BNA Board meeting

Officer Jenny Hall, Community Relations Officer in the San Diego Police Department Mid City Division, was a guest at the July 15 BNA meeting. She provided information about reviving the Neighborhood Watch program, reviewed crime statistics from our region and discussed the nature of recent crimes - mostly theft from unlocked cars and open windows. Hall said that the public can use the ARJIS Web site (www.arjis.org) to get information about recent crimes. Crime data is posted on the site within two or three days of the incident. Hall suggested that residents call the non-emergency police number 619-531-2000 to report suspicious activity. If there is a crime in progress, call 911.

Hall also said that she sometimes posts information on the Nextdoor private social media site. She is not able to see posts made by others, but will reply to private messages sent to her. If you would like an invitation to join Nextdoor, send your request to Jean.Samuels@burlingamesd.com.
