CITY OF SAN DIEGO NEWS

- Slurry sealing of streets in our general area began in June will include Burlingame after sewer work on San Marcos Avenue is completed. Look for a "door hanger" on your front door to warn you of parking restrictions.
- City's draft of regulations for short term rentals - AirBnB, VRBO, etc. - is expected this month, make sure your voice is heard in City Hall.

DROUGHT ALERT

Drought Alert restrictions are in addition to permanent mandatory restrictions in place.

The City of San Diego is strongly urging residents to further reduce their outdoor water use by reducing their outdoor irrigation of lawn and landscaped areas to no more than two days per week, for five minutes per watering station.

Recommended Watering Schedule

Time limits apply to standard sprinkler systems. The 5-minutes-per-day time limit does NOT apply to landscape irrigation systems using water-efficient devices, including drip and micro-irrigation systems and stream rotor sprinklers, but these systems are limited to 3 days per week. Homes with addresses ending in an ODD number are allowed to water only on Sunday and Thursday; EVEN number addresses are allowed to water only on Saturday and Wednesday. Water only after 6 pm and before 10 am.
